## TRANSAXLE OIL

## INSPECTION

- 1. On level ground, jack up the vehicle and support it evenly on safety stands.
- 2. Remove the oil level plug and washer.
- 3. Verify that the oil level is near the lower edge of the plug port.
- 4. If the oil level is low, add the specified amount and type of oil through the plug port.

## Specified oil

Grade: API service GL-4 or GL-5 Viscosity: All season SAE 75W-90

**Above 10°C {50°F} SAE 80W-90** 

5. Install a new washer and the oil level plug.

# **Tightening torque:**

40—58 N·m {4.0—6.0 kgf·m, 29—43 ft·lbf}

#### REPLACEMENT

- 1. On level ground, jack up the vehicle and support it evenly on safety stands.
- 2. Remove the drain plug and washer.
- 3. Drain the oil into a suitable container.
- 4. Install a new washer and the drain plug.

### **Tightening torque:**

40—58 N·m {4.0—6.0 kgf·m, 29—43 ft·lbf}

5. Remove the oil level plug and washer. Add the specified amount and type of oil through the plug port until the level reaches the lower edge of the port.

## Specified oil

Grade: API service GL-4 or GL-5 Viscosity: All season SAE 75W-90

**Above 10°C {50°F} SAE 80W-90** 

Capacity: 2.7 L {2.9 US qt, 2.4 Imp qt}

6. Install a new washer and the oil level plug.

40—58 N·m {4.0—6.0 kgf·m, 29—43 ft·lbf}
